- Registration is open.
- Early registration ends December 31, 2010, Cost \$6,000 per team
- Medium registration ends February 15, 2011 Cost \$7,000 per team
- No registrations will be accepted after March 31, 2011 Cost \$8,000 per team
- Deposit of \$1,500 REQUIRED upon registration.
- Balance of fees due by March 15, 2011
- If the currencies change significantly we reserve the right to define which currency the balance is to be paid in.

For teams completing a portion of the journey:

- Registration opens March 1, 2010
- No registrations will be accepted after March 31, 2011
- Cost is \$150 per day per team. Plus 15% surcharge for medium registrations and 35% for late registrations. And your team mates need to each join the society.

For teams participating in only the final day of the Brigade:

- Registration for the last day may be made at Astoria, Oregon until July 14, 2011.
